Press release issued at the 10th National Business Plan Competition of I Create India

Mumbai, 16th January, 2016: I Create India, with 20 training and program centers throughout India, national headquarters in Bengaluru, and global headquarters in Washington DC, is a Non-Profit Organization dedicated to providing comprehensive and practical entrepreneurship training program. As part of one of its programs meant for youth, I Create India conducted its 10th National Business Plan Competition (NBPC) on 16th January at Suman Ramesh Tulsian Convention Center, Sophia College, Mumbai.

NBPC, a marquee annual event of I Create, is the culmination of the Changing the Mind Set (CMS) program conducted in different educational institutions across the country. CMS is a highly interactive 40 Class program that uses I Create's unique curriculum developed for Indian Youth. It employs highly applauded participatory and interactive techniques for facilitating the learning process. The program provides practical entrepreneurship skills and motivation for the students to consider starting their own business as a viable alternative to seeking jobs which are often not there. I Create's tag line "Creating Job Creators instead of Job Seekers" says it all.

The students around the country who participated in I Create's CMS programs this year prepared individual business plans as the final component of the program. They competed at institutional, center level and then regional level. Twelve finalists from Regional level competitions participated in the NBPC in Mumbai.

The finalists from diverse family backgrounds from different parts of the country are the sons and daughters of school teachers, professors, blue collar workers, corporate and government employees, professionals and, small and medium business persons.

The business ideas of these youth cover a wide range of fields from conventional, innovative and contemporary: Manufacture of Cane Furniture, Pyxis Bricks, Sale of Honey, Computer Classes, Event Management, Tiffin on Wheels, Fish Mart, Women Cab Agency, Dream Gift Boxes etc.

Mr. Ulhas Kamat, CEO I Create India, highlighted the impact CMS program has made on the youth by quoting the statistics from the Pre and Post Tests conducted at the CMS.

"The Entrepreneurship Knowledge Quotient has improved by 25%. The attitude and confidence level among the participants - assessed in terms of likelihood of starting a business in 3 years, assessing new business opportunity, analyzing markets for business opportunity and confidence to finance business has gone up by 33%".
