I Create India collaborates with Kerala Government

What started as an Expression of Interest (EOI) by I Create India in January 2014 has finally fructified in to an agreement between Kerala Government represented by KASE (Kerala Academy for Skills Excellence) and I Create India for conducting Aspiring Entrepreneurship Workshops in five of the selected government ITIs. This is a pilot program under KASE's iSTEP (International Skills Training & Employment Program) initiative.

KASE is the apex agency of Government of Kerala for skill development initiatives in the State and is engaged in planning and implementing skill development programmes and projects for the benefit of the youth at large. It was set up by the Government of Kerala as part of the state skill development mission in January 2012 with the objective of facilitating and coordinating all the skill development initiatives of the state with the aim of ensuring employability of youth and thereby filling the skill gap. It develops appropriate models for setting and operation of institutions for employment linked skill development programmes with the support of private sector operators and end user industries.

ITIs selected by KASE for the pilot are located at Kannur, Kozhikode, Kalamerry, Kollam, and Thiruvananthapuram.

I Create conducted Entrepreneurship Awareness Program (EAP) at these locations from 28th Sept to 1st Oct 2015. I Create team of Ulhas Kamat, Chitra Jagannath & Chandy travelled the coastline. The students were highly appreciative and interacted quite well though they were hesitant initially.

30 students from each ITI have been selected to attend the 5 day Aspiring Entrepreneurs Workshops which are scheduled between 16th November, 2015 and February 2016.
