NIESBUD I Create Business Incubation Centre (NICBIC)

Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship, through NIESBUD (National Institute for Entrepreneurship and Small Business Development), has entered into an MoU with I Create India to collaborate in Entrepreneurship Development through Training and Mentoring.

As a sequel to this, a co-branded Business Incubation Center, known as **NICBIC** (NIESBUD I Create Business Incubation Center), has been established at Bangalore.

NICBIC will be providing Business Incubation Services through its mentors. Protégés would be from our training workshops as well as possible walk-ins. Many local organizations like MSME, NSIC, DIC etc., have also shown keen interest in referring potential entrepreneurs for mentoring services.

Once a Protégé enrolls with NICBIC, he/she is guided in the various aspects of the Mentoring Checklist like Market research, Costing and Pricing, Competition, various Govt. and Bank schemes which help them to start their business. A Bankable business plan prepared by the protégé is the end result of the mentoring exercise.

I Create has developed various outreach material to create awareness about the NICBIC. The brochure is made available at various Govt. Departments and other places where potential candidates visit.

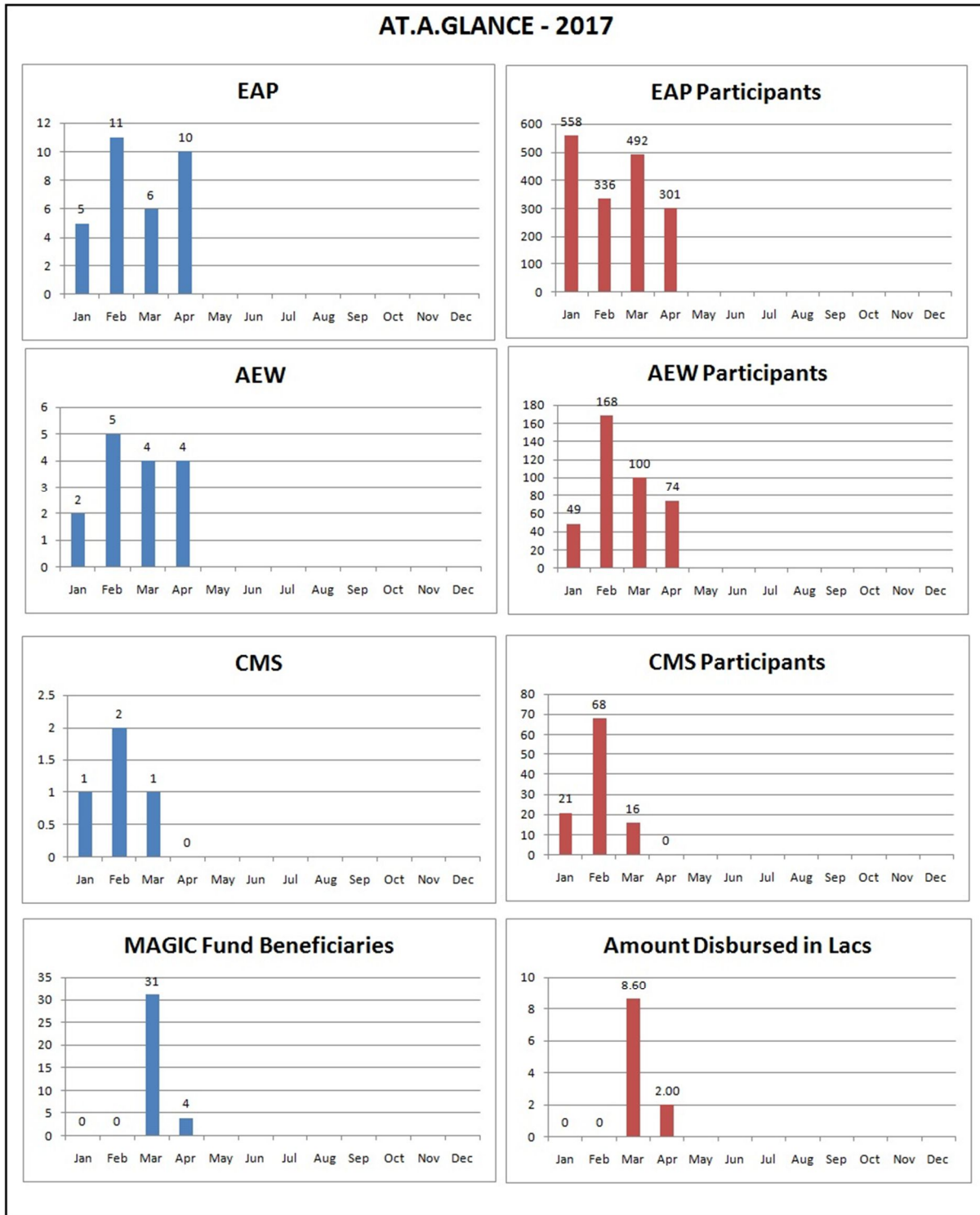
