I Create (I Create along with Goa Chamber of Commerce and Industry (GCCCI) will conduct its inaugural annual Business Plan Competition (BPC) to be held on Friday, the 15th at the GCCCI Hall, Panaji at 10 AM. Addressing a press conference at the GCCCI headquarters, the former GCCCI president Manguirish Pai Raikar said, "I Create India is an 18-year-old non-profit organization with its centres across India. Its core mission is to provide entrepreneurship skills to disadvantaged communities, like self-help groups, unemployed youth. They also encourage college and school students across India and Goa to explore entrepreneurship as a viable career option through."

He also said that in Goa, I Create was set up in October 2011, in association with Goa Chamber of Commerce and Industry. The BPC will involve Goa's premier colleges including Damodar College, Don Bosco, MES, Fr Agnel Institute, Dnyanprassarak, Mandali College, Saraswat, Dempo, Rosary and Carmel College who have undergone the CMS programme.
