<u>Press release issued at the 11th National Business Plan Competition of I Create</u> <u>India</u>

The 11th National Business Plan Competition (NBPC) of I Create India was conducted on 28th January at The Parvatibai Chowgule College, Margao, Goa.

The Thirteen finalists were from diverse family backgrounds from different parts of the country. They are the sons and daughters of school teachers, professors, blue color workers, corporate employees, professionals and, small and medium business persons.

The business ideas of these youth covered a wide range of fields from conventional, innovative to contemporary: Green House Nursery, Sale of Ragi Products, Chaat Centers, Mobile Sales and Services, Food Truck for selling Pre and Post Workout meals, Day care center for Elders and Kids, Chakli Manufacturing, Digital Advertising Sites, Online stores, Best from Waste, Pet Food Store, Edible Cutlery etc.

The Competition was conducted under two categories: Teen (under 19) and NextGen (under 23yrs).

1st Prize -The Hans Foundation Award, with a cash prize of Rs.75,000/- was won by Tejaswini M.S. of Govt. Polytechnic for Women, Bengaluru, Karnataka. She is from the Teen Category and her Business Idea was "Organic Green House Nursery".

2nd Prize -Vimalesh Rani Award, with a cash prize of Rs.50,000/- was won by Selden Fernandes of S.S. Dempo College of Commerce and Economics, Margao, Goa. This was in the NextGen category and his Business Idea was "Food Truck for Pre and Post Workout Meals".

2nd prize in the Teen Category went to Shubha D, 10th std. student from Vivekananda Tribal School for learning, Hosahalli, Mysuru in Karnataka for her idea of "Ragi Products"

3rd prize was bagged by Manthan Kulkarni of Sanjivani Arts, Commerce & Science college, Kopargaon, Ahmadnagar, Maharshtra and his idea was "Chakli Manufacturing".

Jury Appreciation Award went to Hari Kuttan Pillai of ITI Kollam, Kerala. His business idea was "One Stop Mobile Service & Sales".

The Awards Ceremony was held on 28th evening where the prizes were given to the winners of the competition. The Chief Guest for the evening Mr. I Jeyakumar Chairman, Mormugao Port Trust (MPT) and Guest of Honour Mr. Sanjay A Poy Raiturcar, Chairman & Managing Director, Govind Poy Oxygen Ltd., distributed the prizes.

Mr. Ulhas Kamat, CEO I Create India, highlighted the impact CMS program has made on the youth by quoting the statistics from the Pre and Post Tests conducted at the CMS.

"The Entrepreneurship Knowledge Quotient has improved by 33%. The attitude and confidence level among the participants - assessed in terms of likelihood of starting a business in 3 years, assessing new business opportunity, analyzing markets for business opportunity and confidence to finance business has gone up by 33%", Mr. Kamat added.
