### Priya Rana Starts her Business from Home. MAGIC Fund Helps!




25 year old Priya stays in a joint family and the collective income of her husband and father in law who work in a private company was insufficient to meet the ever increasing financial needs of the family of eight.


Priya was very enthusiastic when she found during the I Create Snehdeep, Vadodara workshop that she can use her skill of tailoring to earn money and help


her family financially.


